FEI to Present at Georgia DBHDD Learning Collaborative Understanding how trauma affects behavior and interactions

Solon is responsible for helping organizations determine and implement holistic crisis management systems, organizational development and workplace violence prevention strategies. She also is responsible for the direct delivery of workplace violence prevention, leadership development, employee assistance and crisis management trainings. She is experienced in reviewing current training and policies and procedures to identify gaps as well as work with customers towards a solution. Solon has been featured in several publications and was named "Woman of the Year" for 2012-2013 by the National Association of Professional Women.
